### 2.3 Discuss Implementation of Electronic Raffle – D. Demers

- Dan provided the link to the electronic raffle used by Timmins and District Hospital: <a href="https://www.ascendfs.com/">https://www.ascendfs.com/</a>
- Dan viewed the OLG site that explains how to go about getting a vendor; reached out to various vendors; has a solid understanding of the process; no IT expertise is required
- Reached out to Ascend which does the majority of 50/50 draws in the province
- It takes six weeks to get the gaming documents signed and get on-boarded
- Paul would like to roll this out by February 1, 2021
- Dan shared the details provided by Ascend; the document will be forwarded to the committee members
- Ascend provides the online portal, collection of 50/50 tickets and online payments as well as picks the winner; they also provide support to the client with the process; they suggest hiring a marketing firm; they can put us in touch with them
- There is a cost for this service (\$15,000 a year + merchant and gateway fees of 2.5% and \$0.40 per transaction
- The licence will allow us to use all the different formats for the same fee such as Chase the Ace, auctions, sweepstakes, etc.
- There is also an option to sell paper tickets in various outlets post-COVID
- Once a project manager is hired, he/she will co-manage the online raffles with Dan
- Dan will speak to other vendors and report back to the committee before the committee chooses the vendor
