### 4.0 BUSINESS FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES

- 4.1 Income statement review- Foundation P. Chatelain
  - Still working on improving the statements to reflect year end
  - Donation received for LMH general surgery is reflected in this statement
  - 50/50 allocation is absent from the statement but there is an attached spreadsheet that shows the 50/50
- 4.2 Income statement review SCM Redevelopment P. Chatelain
  - Income statements to be improved and updated
- 4.3 Monthly report (*attached*) A. Lougheed
  - All reporting is up to date
  - 50/50 sales continue to rise with new customers every month; notably increase of customers from Ottawa in March
  - Attended the Cochrane Sportsman Show
  - Organizing the foundations booth at the Iroquois Falls Sportsman Show
  - \$25,000.00 received from the Dr Thompson Estate for LMH General Surgery
  - \$1,000.00/month for 1 year is being donated by the O'Donnells for SCM Redevelopment
  - Met with NOHFC regarding my time in this position
- 4.4 SCM Redevelopment Update P. Chatelain
  - Extension of construction funding subsidy top-up to November 2024
  - \$58/bed is the approximate construction funding subsidy
  - OFA confirmed we are eligible for a \$27 million loan
  - Construction cost is \$42 million
  - Development grant is \$2.8 million
  - Total project cost estimated currently at \$42 million

- The foundation currently has \$1 million in our account
- The Labelle foundation has committed to \$1 million once construction begins
- The town of Iroquois Falls is committed to \$3.3 million
- Timeline: preliminary plans submitted, finance commitment due end of April (but flexible), working drawings submitted and 99% complete, signed development agreement due May 31<sup>st</sup> 2024, licensing and documentation due in May, tendering and bids completed in September 2024.
- The \$8 million campaign needs to be launched and we will look for options on how to best do this.
- Open forum is Iroquois Falls will be coming in June, date to be determined
- 4.5 SCM Redevelopment Fundraising Campaign
  - 4.5.1 Iroquois Falls Sportsman Show G. Forget
    - Will be running a 50/50 and providing information
  - 4.5.2 Cochrane Delegation S. de Laplante
    - Cochrane is working on their budget and they have no further information at this time

  - Shavone has asked to purchase a new mannequin that can be easily transported and more easily maintained
  - Used for BLS, ACLS and TNCC training
  - Cost \$5800
